



# 2017 Track Rules & General Information

1. STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY: Spectators witnessing events assume all risks of injuries or resulting damages.
  2. NO PIT RIDING, Racers may only ride to and from the track to your pit area 1<sup>st</sup> gear idle speed only in full gear, NO DOUBLE RIDING, NO WHEELIES THROUGH THE PIT. Racers subject to disqualification or penalty.
  3. No "Jumping the Fence!" Only racers and staff are allowed on the track. Spectators must remain behind spectator fence.
  4. Riders must have a valid AMA card one AMA card per rider, if you cannot provide an AMA card you must purchase one. Riders must have a valid district card. If riders are racing for District 34 points they must have a current D-34 card.
  5. Riders must properly sign in prior to competing. Anyone found not paying posted fees and riding any way without properly signing in will be escorted off the property and potentially be prosecuted for theft. Minors (under 18) must have notarized paperwork for a guardian, if the parent is not present. **IF there is no parent/guardian and/or proper paperwork; NO Track Time... NO Exceptions!!**
- \*\*\*All riders must sign all release forms.** Minors and parents both must complete the minor release form for all riders under 18.
6. Riders & Spectators must wear wristbands at all times during the event
  7. All races rules are based on the 2017 AMA competition rule book
  8. Riders are responsible for their actions and for the actions of their pit crew, family and friends. Fights, vandalism or behavior deemed irresponsible will potentially result in the rider's disqualification from the event. Depending on the severity of the situation, the rider, pit crew and any family member will be asked to leave or escorted off of the property.
  9. Riders must wear proper protection including boots, long sleeve jersey or shirt, goggles and helmet, recommended protection includes gloves, chest protectors, racing pants, knee pads or braces and neck brace.
  10. Due to Local Fire Ordinance, No open fires or Fireworks of any kind are permitted at Raceway Park.
  11. Do Not Set Up Business In You Pit Area. Absolutely no vending or merchandising of any type without approval from Raceway Park Management. This is also known as "Suitcasing", a practice that unethical vendors or businesses use to access an event by purchasing access for a minimal fee and then soliciting business. This practice undercuts legitimate vendors or sponsors who are supporting the track and are paying a set fee to be a vendor at the facility.
  12. Refunds: Please walk the track prior to practice, if you feel as though you are unable to compete or ride the track immediately report to the tower and request a refund. Once practice has started there are No Refunds.
  13. Please keep all pets on a leash at all times. This is for the safety of riders and spectators and for the safety of your pet.
  14. HAVE FUN!!! We all are here because we have motocross and racing in common. Let's be safe, follow the rules and have a great race day!! Race to win and enjoy the comradery with your fellow racers when you're off the track.
  15. Emergency information, in the event a rider or individual needs to be transported to the hospital. One of the following hospitals will be used, check with the staff for confirmation of the hospital they are transporting to.
